

Our first meeting of 2023 is on Tuesday 7 February at 2pm when we will welcome Mr John Harris, a volunteer with the Commonwealth War Graves Commission to give us a presentation on their work.

The Commonwealth War Graves Commission (CWGC) is an intergovernmental organisation whose principal function is to mark, record and maintain the graves and places of commemoration of Commonwealth of Nations military service members who died in the two World Wars. The commission is also responsible for commemorating Commonwealth civilians who died as a result of enemy action during the Second World War. The commission was founded by Sir Fabian Ware and constituted through Royal Charter in 1917.

The Commission, as part of its mandate, is responsible for commemorating all war dead individually and equally. To this end, the war dead are commemorated by a name on a headstone, at an identified site of a burial, or on a memorial. War dead are commemorated uniformly and equally, irrespective of military or civil rank, race or creed.

Mr Harris's talk will include reference to the four Commission War graves in the churchyard at St John the Baptists, Harrietsham.

Hopefully the weather will be good in February and you will be able to come along, visitors are always welcome to attend our meetings for a small charge of £3.00.

There are a total of 274 trees. The Eastern side of Beech Walk currently has 219 trees standing, with only one of these close to Court Lodge Road which has split with half of it on the ground. On the Western side there are 55 trees standing, six of these are replants, and there are signs of two trees being missing.

Let us hope the trees continue to survive the changes in our weather and will still be there for everyone to enjoy for a long time.

Len Valley Practice Update

Many of you are aware that we switched on EPS (Electronic Prescription Service) earlier this year. This allowed us to electronically send prescriptions to a patients nominated pharmacy electronically. This meant that prescriptions were issued to pharmacies within 2 working days and removed the need to physically collect the paper prescription and hand deliver.

Although this works for most patients, we have had experiences where a patient still wants to collect a paper prescription or has experienced issues with obtaining a new repeat prescription form from their chosen pharmacy.

The practice has decided from 1 January to send all non-dispensing patients prescription's electronically, via EPS thus reducing the queues and waiting times for those patients collecting medication from our dispensary.

Your chosen pharmacy can print off repeat order forms and this should be requested when medication is collected. If you continue to have issues obtaining a repeat prescription, then we recommend that you sign up for the NHS app which enables you to view your repeat medication.

Some patients currently use Patient Access, this will continue to be available, however the NHS app is a more user friendly and accessible on all devices.

We want to help make the process of ordering a repeat prescription as easy as possible for our patients, both dispensing and non-dispensing.

If you currently collect a paper prescription or token, please nominate your chosen pharmacy so the system is straightforward for you in the new year. All prescriptions: acute or repeat will be sent direct to them for dispensing. You will need to contact your chosen pharmacy for specific collection times and discuss any delivery requirements. REMEMBER to ask for a repeat prescription print out when collecting your prescription if you need a paper copy.

Harrietsham History Society

Banks Bakery Site, West Street - 1841 - 1972

The earliest documented history regarding the site used as a bakery goes back to the census of 1841 when the site was occupied by Robert Churchill. Robert Churchill was still listed as site owner in the 1851 and in 1861 census he is listed as site owner together with his daughter, Emily Churchill as assistant. Emily, who never married, died in 1870 and the site transferred to the Bigg Family.



The 1871 census shows the site was occupied by John Bigg and by 1891 Frederick George Bigg his son. Frederick George Bigg continued on until 1928 when it passed to his son.



In 1930, Kelly's directory still shows the site being run by Frederick George Bigg (Junior). The first mention of Banks Bakery is the phone book of 1943. According to the national archives, Banks Bakeries was acquired by Cranfields's Limited in 1936 and the last listed accounts being 1972.



Christian Message

Love is in the air!

This month we celebrate Valentine's Day and many will prepare elaborate displays of love for those nearest and dearest to them! Perhaps you'll be writing a card, buying a gift or presenting some flowers to someone special in your life? Valentine's Day can also serve as a welcome reminder that even our most sincere expressions displays of love cannot come close to the love that we have received from God.

In the Gospel of Luke (15:11-32) Jesus shares the parable of 'The Prodigal Son'. It tells of a son who asks his father for his share of the inheritance whilst his father is still living. Despite how hurtful this would have been, the father agrees and gives his son the money. The son soon moves away and squanders the inheritance on wild living. He runs out of money, hits rock bottom and eventually decides to return home and ask his dad to live as one of his servants. The incredible twist comes in the father's response to his son and it is designed to show us the love of our Heavenly Father towards us. Rather than reject or berate his son, the father ran to meet him and embraced him in a huge bear hug. He bestowed gifts upon him and laid on an extravagant feast to celebrate that his son had returned home.

Beyond displaying God's love through parables, Jesus demonstrated it through his life and ultimately through his death. The theologian Thomas Goodwin put it this way; "Christ is love covered in flesh". Jesus showed that there is no length that our Father God won't go to in order to lavish love upon us. All we need to do is begin the walk home and receive the embrace of the Father who runs to meet us.

I'll give the final word to the author Dane Ortlund who beautifully states; "Even the most intense human love is but the faintest echo of heaven's cascading abundance. His heartfelt thoughts for you outstrip what you can conceive."
