How to join the Fish Scheme AGM using Zoom

If you have not used Zoom before, you will need to search for Zoom online in your web browser and download Zoom to your computer. Set up your Zoom membership to the email address you want to use and notify Peter.78brown@btinternet.com that you wish to join the meeting and that you will join it from your email address which is..... If you don't notify Peter of the email address you are using for Zoom, he will not be able to send you an invitation and you will not be able to attend.

At the appointed time on Monday 8 March, click on the link in Peter's email invitation to you. This should take you straight into the meeting. Make sure that you agree to using video and microphones when you join. If you wish to vote on any matters during the meeting you must be visible on screen for your votes to count. If the link does not work, go to 'Join meeting' in your Zoom screen and enter the meeting ID Number and your name, followed by the passcode when requested.

At times during the meeting microphones may be switched off to enable speakers to speak without interruption. If you urgently need to communicate during those times please use the chat option. Only select 'everyone' if you intend the whole meeting to see it. If not, please select the name of the attendee you wish to communicate with.

May we suggest you explore the Zoom screen by setting up a new meeting and hovering your mouse around the screen and clicking on the various icons when they appear to familiarise yourself with the controls.

At the meeting we regret that if you can't get in, we will not be able to troubleshoot, so perhaps if you are new to Zoom, you could arrange to 'meet' with a friend so that you can make sure you are connecting and that your video and audio are working. The first time can sometimes be tricky, but after that it generally runs smoothly. If you really can't sort it out you can send an email requesting help to Jan at editor@harrietshamfishscheme.org or call her on 07484 310307 (10.00am to 8.00pm only). If there is no reply, please leave your name, phone number and a brief message and Jan will call you back. This will not be before 10.00am or after 8.00pm.

We will explain how to vote on the night. Please make sure you know where the participants tab is so that you can see the list of people attending the meeting.

Please be advised the meeting will not be videoed but will be recorded.

At the end of the meeting the host will close the Zoom window for all attendees. If you want to leave before that please hover the mouse and find and click on the red 'end' tab and then select 'leave meeting'.

This is 'First' for us, so please be patient if we take a few minutes to sort things out.

Meadow Larks at Teers Meadow

Would anyone like to join me to form a Friends of Teers Meadow group and get involved in discovering more about this lovely field in Harrietsham and how to look after it? The meadow is a rare fragment of chalk grassland, a globally important habitat. The UK is home to about half of the world's chalk grassland and Kent is a great place to explore it.

We already have a good idea of the plants that grow in the meadow, from common spotted and pyramidal orchids in spring to wild basil and field scabious in summer, when the flowers are busy with common blue butterflies, green hairstreaks and grizzled skippers. The site is home to slow-worms and viviparous lizards, too. You can find out more by taking a stroll over to Teers Meadow where you'll see helpful information and identification panels installed by the gates.

As a Friends group, we could organise bird-watching days, butterfly and moth surveys, evening bat walks. We could identify insects, look out for signs of small mammals and reptiles – and keep records of everything we spot. These are all great family activities, as well as a good way to get away from everyday worries for an hour or two.

There will be practical jobs, too, such as scrub-clearing and keeping paths clear. We might even consider creating a pond. Teers Meadow received Heritage Lottery Funding, which includes a budget for training and workshops with wildlife specialists, so you don't need any prior knowledge or skills. A meadow management plan has already been drawn up by experts, so we'll have a good idea of how to proceed.

Harrietsham in Bloom Volunteers March 2021



March should bring a fine display of daffodils after all the effort put in by our volunteers in planting up 10,000 bulbs last autumn. Three different varieties were planted – King Alfred, Dutch Master and Ice Follies and we also planted up several hundred “spare” tulips which are very early flowering dwarf varieties. The next task will be topping up with spring bedding – primulas and polyanthus – which hopefully will last to the end of May when we then do our summer bedding displays.

Top Tips

from

Harrietsham Gardening Society

March is an unpredictable month in the garden. It is easy to be lured by warm, sunny days into thinking that winter is over but we can still get very sharp frosts and even snow, so best not to get too carried away too early. In the vegetable garden or allotment it's generally safe from the middle of the month to plant out new potatoes which hopefully you've had chitting away for the last few weeks. Plant these in rows two feet apart and about a foot apart in the row, or in containers at least a foot diameter if you haven't got much garden or space. The advantage of growing in containers is you can stand these in a greenhouse, conservatory or under a bit of polythene for protection and really bring them on until all danger of frost is past. You should have early new potatoes to fight over and smother in butter the first week in June. New potatoes cooked with a bit of mint, new carrots, succulent summer cabbage smothered with butter and salt followed by your own strawberries for dessert and award yourself a skyful of Michelin stars.

Parsnips, early peas such as Feltham first, onion sets and summer cabbages can be sown/planted now and a few early carrots and lettuces can also be sown at the end of the month. Little gem lettuces are generally very reliable; sow these in trays or pots on a windowsill or anywhere with plenty of light and plant outside as soon as they're large enough to handle. Some protection from slugs and birds will be necessary. If you've got a propagator get your tomatoes going now, it's best to sow the seeds singly if you can to avoid root disturbance when you pot on or plant out. If you don't have a propagator consider investing in a heat mat on which you can stand trays or pots, as it's bottom heat which makes all the difference to germination and establishment.

As for flowers, if you sowed sweet peas last autumn you can plant those out against individual canes or a net support late this month ready for a wonderful display in June, otherwise it's not too late to sow them now. As snowdrop flower heads fade, split up any overcrowded clumps and replant and as flower heads fade on early daffodils and narcissi cut the heads off to ensure as much energy as possible goes back into the bulb as the leaves start to die down. Many flower seeds traditionally sown for bedding can be started off this month, petunias, lobelia, ageratum, tagetes, alyssum etc. to name but a few. Again, light is so important to prevent seedlings being drawn up and susceptible to damping-off when they will collapse at soil level. Similarly, if you want to increase stocks of dahlias place tubers in compost in a six inch pot and they'll soon throw up shoots which when three or four inches high are easily rooted as cuttings.

Worn patches on the lawn can be reseeded this month and after all the heavy rain a good forking can help with aeration and drainage. If you want to get rid of moss on the lawn this is the month to apply moss killer and don't cut the grass too short until it's more actively growing or you will encourage moss to come in.

That's all for this month, happy gardening.


